QUARTERLY HIGHLIGHTS

Since June 1, the market's rally has broadened, and MDI ESG's relative performance has improved. In Q3, the portfolio was down modestly and outperformed the Russell 1000® Value Index, net of fees. However, this relative progress was not enough to offset the slow start to the year. Over a longer period, the portfolio has modestly outperformed the benchmark since inception, net of fees.

The key reason for MDI ESG's performance lag this year is that very few of the stocks responsible for the market's strength this year are dividend payors and are not candidates for inclusion in the portfolio. The portfolio's results are in line with other dividend indexes through September 30*. As the market rally continues to broaden, we expect that the portfolio's results will bounce back nicely in absolute terms and relative to the Russell 1000 Value Index.

Companies in the portfolio had another strong quarter of operations. The significant majority of the portfolio's holdings have raised their dividends in 2023, and we expect more to do so in the fourth quarter.

We believe the MDI ESG portfolio should rebound strongly as the market's returns continue to broaden and this year's underperformance provides an excellent entry point.

The Matrix ESG Dividend Income Composite contains fully discretionary dividend income equity accounts that invest in high-quality U.S. large cap value companies that pay high dividends consistently and have raised their dividends historically. For comparison purposes the composite is measured against the S&P 500° Index and Russell 1000° Value Index. The S&P 500° Index is an index that measures the performance of 500 publicly traded companies, which are among the largest in the United States. As of January, 2018, it is also measured against the Russell 1000 Value° Index, an index which measures the performance of the companies in the Russell 1000° Index with lower price-to-book ratios and lower forecasted growth values. The Russell 1000 Value° Index was added as a benchmark as it reflects the investment style of the strategy. The minimum account size for this composite is \$100,000.

Matrix Asset Advisors, Inc. claims compliance with the Global Investment Performance Standards (GIPS*) and has prepared and presented this report in compliance with the GIPS standards. Matrix Asset Advisors, Inc. has been independently verified for the periods 1/1/92 through 12/31/22 Verification assesses whether (1) the firm has complied with all the composite construction requirements of the GIPS standards on a firm-wide basis and (2) the firm's policies and procedures are designed to calculate and present performance in compliance with the GIPS standards. The Dividend Income Composite has been examined for the periods January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2022 The verification and performance examination reports are available upon request. Matrix Asset Advisors, Inc. is a registered investment adviser that manages equity and fixed income assets for client accounts. The firm's list of composite descriptions is available upon request.

Results are based on fully discretionary accounts under management, Since inception, the composite policy requires the temporary removal of any portfolio incurring a client initiated significant cash inflow or outflow of 15% or greater of portfolio assets. Net of fee performance was calculated using the highest management fee of 0.65%, as per our fee schedule and applied quarterly. The annual composite dispersion presented is an asset-weighted standard deviation calculated for the accounts in the composite the entire year. Additional information regarding the policies for valuing portfolios, calculating performance, and preparing compliant presentations are available upon request. The management fee schedule is as follows: 0.65% on the first \$5,000,000 of assets under management, 0.55% on the next \$5,000,000 of assets under management, 0.45% on the next \$25,000,000 of assets under management, 0.35% on the next \$50,000,000 of assets under management and 0.30% on assets under management in excess of \$100,000,000. Dividend Yield is a financial ratio that tells you the percentage of a company's share price that it pays out in dividends each year. Annualized Returns - an annualized rate of return is calculated as the equivalent annual return an investor receives over a given period. The Global Investment Performance Standards dictate that returns of portfolios or composites for periods of less than one year may not be annualized. This prevents "projected" performance in the remainder of the year from occurring.

Market Capitalization Weighted is average market capitalization is a type of market index in which each component is weighted according to the size of its total market capitalization. Market capitalization is the sum of the total value of a company's outstanding shares multiplied by the price of one share.
